Utrecht, The Netherlands, Thursday June 2 and Friday June 3, 2016

The conference will be preceded by an 'Honours in Utrecht Tour' on Wednesday June 1, during which students and faculty of both institutions will present and discuss their honours activities and honours ambitions. There will also be a pre-conference programme in Groningen, May 30 to June 1, with a focus on honours teaching.

Central theme

The Dutch incentive programme for honours (SIRIUS) gave an enormous boost to honours in Dutch higher education. Now that the programme is phasing out, higher education institutions and their honours communities are working hard to ensure a strong future for honours, to make their honours activities and networks sustainable and structurally embedded.
